Dear Mr. Kulkarni,

Please find enclosed two cheques in the amounts of \$10,500 and \$3,000. The first check of \$10,500 is from a grant given to *Asha for Education – NYC/NJ* by the *I2 foundation*, and the second is from an individual donor who was impressed by the work being done at the New Modern School. As was communicated in our letter to you earlier in the year, these two cheques fulfill our funding commitments to the *New Modern Trust*.

The amount of \$10,500 from the *I2 Foundation* is meant solely for the purpose of constructing the new school building. Both *Asha for Education* and the *I2 Foundation* require regular updates about the progress of the school. Since our relationship with the Foundation, and hence our ability to help other worthy projects, depends heavily on such updates and feedback, we strongly urge you to supply us with good records and supporting documentation. Such documentation may take the form of annual reports, yearly financials, photographs of the old and new schools, testimonials from students and parents etc.

The amount of \$3,000 from the individual donor (Mr. Amresh Wagle of New Jersey, USA) must be used towards any other education-related expenses, such as the purchase of schoolbooks, teacher's salaries, etc. Once again, good records and regular updates will help us maintain good relations with an important donor.

We are very pleased to have been able to fund such a large fraction of your project costs, and we hope that this will significantly improve the ability of the school to realise its full potential. We hope the New Modern School flourishes and achieves its aim of providing a happy environment in which to educate the children of the local community.
